Denial of Requested Accommodation by Faculty

As required under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, faculty should consider all reasonable alternatives to a recommended accommodation(s) before denying an accommodation(s). Faculty must engage in an interactive process with the Disability & Access Center and the student to determine if there are any reasonable alternatives.

In completing the interactive process, the faculty member must determine if the originally requested accommodation 1.) can be approved, or 2.) if a reasonable alternative can be agreed upon by the student, DAC and instructor or 3.) if the accommodation must be denied because it would fundamentally alter the design of the course or its academic standards. If the faculty member believes that the accommodation must be denied, he or she must complete this form. Please note that signatures are required, and the form will be kept on file in the office of the DAC. This will allow us to document that the interactive process was completed and the outcome of the process, should further review be required.
